FAIR WORK COMISSION

The Fair Work Commission annual wage review has delivered an increase of 5.75% in

the rates of pay for Modern Awards, effective from the first full pay period commencing on or after 1 July 2023. This increase is exclusive of the 0.5% increase in superannuation, that also takes effect from 01 July 2023, bringing the increase to 6.25%. ProVision members are obligated to ensure they are paying each employee at least
